- The majority of the competitors were in their 4th semester
- Overall average age was approximately 25
- Ten competitors held previous degrees, one competitor was a veteran
- Over eight percent of the finalists received scholarship funds



- Will be released in time for BTS 2017






New Full Color book and cover

- Will be released in time for BTS 2017







